Course Titles: Principles of Healthcare (7168), Health Science:Special Topics (5286)

Location: VUJ Campus- Classroom Classroom Building

Class time: 8:00-9:30, 10:00-11:30, 1:25-2:55

Credits per semester: 2

Description: extended laboratory experience at the student's choice of clinical sites designed to provide students the opportunity to shadow healthcare professionals. Students will learn in the classroom, including information on the health care system and employment opportunities at a variety of entry levels, an overview of the health care delivery systems, health care teams and legal and ethical considerations. It prepares students with the knowledge, skills and attitudes essential for providing basic care in extended care facilities, hospitals and home health agencies under the direction of licensed nurses. These knowledge and skills include recording patient medical histories and symptoms, providing medicine and treatments, consulting doctors, operating and monitoring medical equipment, witnessing first hand the jobs/roles of providers by allowing students to select rotations in seven different areas of their choosing. This course also provides students with the knowledge, attitudes, and skills needed to make the transition from school to advance in their future medical careers, including self analysis to aid in career selection, job seeking and job maintenance skills, personal management skills, and completion of the application process for admission into a post secondary program.
