EMS/EMT

Course Titles: Principles of Healthcare (7168), Medical Terminology (5274), EMT (7165)

Location: VUJC Classroom Building, Memorial Hospital

Class time: 8:10-10:05

Credits Per Semester: 3

Description: This course is designed for individuals desiring to perform emergency medical care. Students will learn to recognize the seriousness of the patient's condition, use the appropriate emergency care techniques and equipment to stabilize the patient, and transport to the hospital. Students meeting appropriate standards will be eligible for certification by the National Registry of EMTs and the State of Indiana as Emergency Medical Technicians. This class also provides an opportunity for a great variety of experiences into the healthcare world. There is a classroom, skills lab, computer lab and a clinical component required.

Dual Credit: VU- HSGN 102, HIMT 110, EMTB 212

Prerequisites/Requirements for application: Students must be 18 years of age in order to take the EMT certification exam. Students need to turn 18 within 3 months of completing the course. We prefer 12 grade students but may accept 11 graders if they turn 18 during their junior year of school.
