

Internship



Overview

Internship is also known as Work Based Learning. This class is offered to seniors in each of the Dubois County schools. The purpose of Internship is to provide a “real world” experience in the career that a student wishes to pursue. Prior to the Internship, students must have completed a pathway of courses to prepare them for the Internship experience. Internship is typically year long and arrangements may be made to offer a student experiences in two different career disciplines if desired.

Requirements

Students interested in Internship must:

- Be a high school senior.
- Have a 95% attendance rate.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Jasper students need a 3.0 or higher with the weighted scale.
- Have a reliable means of transportation.
- Have a strong work ethic, strong communication skills, and a desire to learn.
- Have completed a course pathway related to the career discipline prior to requesting an internship. Students that have taken at least some classes related to the career discipline will be considered.

Details

- Internships are typically not paid.
- Internship is 2 periods of the school day.
- Internship is typically a year long course.
- The Internship Coordinator will line up internships for students. After the initial contact with an employer, the student may be asked to follow up with that employer regarding an Internship placement.
- Students are expected to take part in a “meet and greet” prior to being placed at an Internship site.
- Along with daily participation in the Internship, students will be required to complete various assignments online pertaining to the Internship class.
