

Internship

(Work Based Learning)



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Overview

Internship is also known as Work Based Learning and is offered to seniors in each of the Dubois County schools. Internship serves as a capstone to Career and Technical Education pathways providing “real world” experiences in professional careers. **Students are required to take an advanced CTE course related to the internship discipline they request.**

**Students seeking medical career experience must take HOSA at VUJC. This class has embedded clinical rotations along with a classroom component.*

***Students seeking business experience must take Business Management Operations at VUJC. This class has an embedded internship along with a classroom component.*

Requirements

Students interested in Internship must:

- Be a high school senior.
- Have a 95% attendance rate.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale. Jasper students need a 3.0 or higher with weighted scale.
- Not have a history of behavior concerns that would make an employer question your character and or ability to be a productive employee.
- Have a reliable means of transportation.
- **Have taken an advanced CTE course related to the internship discipline they request.**
- Have a strong work ethic, strong communication skills, and a desire to learn.

Details

- Internships may be unpaid or paid, however in most cases are not paid.
- Internship is typically 2 periods of the school day at the beginning or end of the day and is year long.
- The WBL coordinator will help line up Internship placements for students. Please note that every effort will be made to make placements, however placements for all students cannot be guaranteed.
- Students are required to participate in approximately 5 hours per week of school-based instruction, focused on employability and skills development. This will be online based through Google Classroom.
